Motion was made by Hall and seconded by Gorley to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.

Motion was made by Walker and seconded by Gorley to approve proposed Resolution to authorize an application for a Community Development Block Grant and authorize the Mayor to sign. Motion carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.

Nick Kouloungis of Middle Georgia Regional Commission gave a presentation on proposed Urban Redevelopment Plan for the City of Eatonton.

Motion was made by Walker and seconded by Hall to approve resolution and adopt proposed Map Boundary that outlined the Urban Redevelopment area as presented by Middle Georgia Regional Commission. Motion carried by a unanimous vote of 5-0.

Motion was made by Hall and seconded by Stokes to adopt proposed Resolution for the Urban Redevelopment Plan. Motion carried by a unanimous vote of 5-0.

Motion was made by Walker and seconded by Hall to pay bills if and when funds become available. Motion carried by a unanimous vote of 5-0.

Councilman Gorley advised the City crew is putting up the Christmas decorations.

Councilman Hall advised today is the first day that the City of Eatonton has a full time Fire Department. Also the City has received the architectural plans for the addition to the Fire Department building.

City Administrator Dan Elmore advised Family Connection and the Food Bank have relocated to the old Gas building next door.

The Gas storage shed demolition is about complete.

The City had some bad weather and some blown down trees took the street department off schedule on limbs and leaves. They should get back on schedule by weeks end.

Christmas lights are going up and crew should be finished by this week.

Motion was made by Stokes and seconded by Hall to adjourn. Motion carried by a unanimous vote of 5-0.
